The summer program encourages students to draw on their academic and personal experiences, and unique talents to enhance the work at Chemonics and in the field of global development.

The Internship Experience

Learning. Interns participate in learning events and engage in discussions with Chemonics' senior staff and experts. Interns are also paired with mentors to gain career development insights and support.

Training. Interns receive custom training that helps equip them to become future leaders in the field.

Development. Interns work on meaningful and engaging tasks that contribute to the important daily work of Chemonics' teams, as they develop essential skills that prepare them for career success.

Exposure. Interns observe and experience the *real* work of international development implementation, gaining exposure to such areas as USAID contracting and compliance, and Chemonics' systems, processes, and technical capacities.

- All positions are full-time and paid

The program is open to current undergraduate and graduate students. Qualifications include:

- Enrolled, rising junior, senior, or graduate student continuing studies in the fall semester
- Good academic standing – minimum 3.0 GPA
- Demonstrated interest in international development
- English proficiency
- Legal authorization to work in the United States
