3	Will the employment contracts of the 111 project staff embedded to Zambia Medicines and Medical Supplies Agency (ZMMSA) and Zambia Medicines Regulatory Authority (ZAMRA) be under the subcontractor's name?	Yes, they will be under the subcontractor's name (They will be submitting NAPSA, NHI, Personal levy and PAYEE under the subcontractor's company name)
4	Kindly clarify whether the one time fee to issue and modify fixed term agreements per employee will require a modification of one general contract or there are categories of employee contracts. If there are categories of employee contracts, please advise how many they are?	There will be 2 categories of agreements, under ZAMMSA and ZAMRA embedded staff.
