#### **Section 1: Instructions to Offerors**

Introduction: The Global Health Supply Chain - Procurement and Supply Management (GHSC-PSM) Project is a USAID program implemented by Chemonics International in Uganda. The goal of the GHSC-PSM project is to contribute to increased access to key health commodities through efficient procurement and timely delivery to USAID-supported service delivery points. As part of project activities, the GHSC-PSM project requires the purchase of barcoding equipment and equipment installation services to implement barcode technology enhancements to the three Joint Medical Store warehouse management system in Kampala, Uganda. The purpose of this RFQ is to solicit quotations for these services.

Offerors are responsible for ensuring that their offers are received by Chemonics in accordance with the instructions, terms, and conditions described in this RFQ. Failure to adhere with instructions described in this RFQ may lead to disqualification of an offer from consideration.

2. <u>Offer Deadline and Protocol</u>: Offers must be received no later than 5:00PM local Washington, DC time on February 15th, 2022 by email to the GHSC-PSM office. All offers must be submitted electronically, emailed offers must be emailed to <u>UgandaPSMPMU@ghsc-psm.org</u>.

Please reference the RFQ number in any response to this RFQ. Offers received after the specified time and date will be considered late and will be considered only at the discretion of Chemonics.

3. <u>Questions</u>: Questions regarding the technical or administrative requirements of this RFQ may be submitted no later than 5:00PM local Washington, DC time on February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 by email to <u>UgandaPSMPMU@ghsc-psm.org</u>. Questions must be submitted in writing; phone calls will not be accepted. Questions and requests for clarification—and the responses thereto—that Chemonics believes may be of interest to other offerors will be circulated to all RFQ recipients who have indicated an interest in bidding.

Only the written answers issued by Chemonics will be considered official and carry weight in the RFQ process and subsequent evaluation. Any verbal information received from employees of Chemonics or any other entity should not be considered as an official response to any questions regarding this RFQ.

4. **Scope of Work**: Section 3 contains the Scope of Work for the required services.

**Quotations**: Quotations in response to this RFQ must be priced on a fixed-price, all-inclusive basis. Prices must be presented in USD. Prices must be inclusive of all costs (including worker's compensation insurance mandated by U.S. Defense Base Act (DBA insurance). Offers must remain valid for not less than thirty (30) calendar days after the offer deadline. Offerors are requested to provide quotations on their official quotation format or letterhead; in the event this is not possible, offerors may complete the table in Section 3.

In addition, offerors responding to this RFQ are requested to submit the following:

- Organizations responding to this RFQ are requested to submit a copy of their official registration or business license.
- Individuals responding to this RFQ are requested to submit a copy of their identification card
- A minimum of three (3) references (with name and contact information) indicating the relevant services carried out in the last three (3) years that best illustrate

organization/individual's qualifications and past performance. References from USAID or similar donor-funded projects are preferred. Independent verification of the references may be carried out. Chemonics reserves the right to obtain past performance information from sources other than those identified by the offeror;

Narrative description of past performance for similar services;

The price quotation be submitted separately from above documents. All other parts of this quotation must not make reference to pricing data in order that the technical evaluation may be made strictly on the basis of technical merit.

- 5. **Delivery**: As part of its response to this RFQ, each offeror is expected to provide an estimate (in calendar days) of the delivery timeframe (after receipt of order). The delivery estimate presented in an offer in response to this RFQ must be upheld in the performance of any resulting contract
- Source/Nationality/Manufacture: All services offered in response to this RFQ or supplied under any resulting award must meet USAID Geographic Code 935 in accordance with the United States Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), 22 CFR §228. The cooperating country for this RFQ is Uganda.

Offerors may <u>not</u> offer or supply services or any commodities that are manufactured or assembled in, shipped from, transported through, or otherwise involving any of the following countries: Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria.

Any and all items that are made by Huawei Technology Company, ZTE Corporation, Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikivision Digital Technology Company, Dahua Technology Company will not be accepted. If quotes include items from these entities, please note that they will be deemed not technically responsive, and excluded from competition.

#### 7. Taxes and VAT:

The agreement under which this procurement is financed is not exempt from the payment of taxes, VAT, tariffs, duties, or other levies imposed by any laws in effect in the Cooperating Country. Therefore, offerors must include taxes, VAT, charges, tariffs, duties and levies in accordance with the laws of the Cooperating Country.

- 8. <u>DUNS Number:</u> Companies or organizations, whether for-profit or non-profit, shall be requested to provide a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number if selected to receive an award in response to this RFQ valued greater than or equal to USD\$30,000 (or equivalent in other currency). If the Offeror does not have a DUNS number and is unable to obtain one before the submission deadline, Offeror shall include a statement noting their intention to register for a DUNS number should it be selected as the successful offeror or explaining why registration for a DUNS number is not possible. - 9. <u>Eligibility</u>: By submitting an offer in response to this RFQ, the offeror certifies that it and its principal officers are not debarred, suspended, or otherwise considered ineligible for an award by the U.S. Government. Chemonics will not award a contract to any firm that is debarred, suspended, or considered to be ineligible by the U.S. Government.

<u>Evaluation and Basis for Award</u>: The award will be made to a responsible offeror whose offer follows the RFQ instructions, meets the eligibility requirements; meets or exceeds the minimum required technical specifications and is judged to be the best value based on a lowest-price, technically-acceptable basis.

Please note that if there are significant deficiencies regarding responsiveness to the requirements of this RFQ, an offer may be deemed "non-responsive" and thereby disqualified from consideration. Chemonics reserves the right to waive immaterial deficiencies at its discretion.

Best-offer quotations are requested. It is anticipated that award will be made solely on the basis of these original quotations. However, Chemonics reserves the right to conduct any of the following:

- Chemonics may conduct negotiations with and/or request clarifications from any offeror prior to award.
- While preference will be given to offerors who can address the full technical requirements of this RFQ, Chemonics may issue a partial award or split the award among various Vendors, if in the best interest of the GHSC-PSM Project.
- Chemonics may cancel this RFQ at any time.
- Chemonics may reject any and all offers, if such action is considered to be in the best interest of Chemonics.

Please note that in submitting a response to this RFQ, the offeror understands that USAID is not a party to this solicitation and the offeror agrees that any protest hereunder must be presented—in writing with full explanations—to the GHSC-PSM Project for consideration, as USAID will not consider protests regarding procurements carried out by implementing partners. Chemonics, at its sole discretion, will make a final decision on the protest for this procurement.

10. <u>Terms and Conditions</u>: This is a Request for Quotations only. Issuance of this RFQ does not in any way obligate Chemonics, the GHSC-PSM Project, or USAID to make an award or pay for costs incurred by potential offerors in the preparation and submission of an offer.

This solicitation is subject to Chemonics' standard terms and conditions. Any resultant award will be governed by these terms and conditions; a copy of the full terms and conditions is available upon request. Please note the following terms and conditions will apply:

- (a) Chemonics' standard payment terms are net 30 days after receipt and acceptance of any commodities or deliverables. Payment will only be issued to the entity submitting the offer in response to this RFQ and identified in the resulting award; payment will not be issued to a third party.
- (b) Any award resulting from this RFQ will be firm fixed price, in the form of a purchase order.
- (c) No services or commodities may be supplied that are manufactured or assembled in, shipped from, transported through, or otherwise involving any of the following countries: Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria.
- (d) Any international air or ocean transportation or shipping carried out under any award resulting from this RFQ must take place on U.S.-flag carriers/vessels.
- (e) United States law prohibits transactions with, and the provision of resources and support to, individuals and organizations associated with terrorism. The Vendor under any award resulting from this RFQ must ensure compliance with these laws.
- (f) The title to any goods supplied under any award resulting from this RFQ shall pass to Chemonics following delivery and acceptance of the goods by Chemonics. Risk of loss, injury, or destruction of the goods shall be borne by the offeror until title passes to Chemonics.

#### **Section 3: Scope of Work and Technical Qualifications**

The purpose of this RFQ is to engage the firm to provide barcoding equipment and installation services to Chemonics and GHSC-PSM in Uganda. The firm shall, and when requested, provide the following services:

The project will require installation of full RF coverage of the warehouse, therefore a quote to return at a later date to install the needed remaining access points is also requested.

Drawings of the warehouses are available upon request to assist in verifying/quantifying the needed total access points required.

#### **Technical Qualifications that the selected offeror must possess:**

A Minimum of 5 years of experience and proven track of record providing the services outlined in Scope of Work is required. Staff assigned to these tasks must have minimum 5 of years of experience and have completed all required certifications and licenses required by local law and regulations. Experience with USAID or other donor-funded projects in Uganda especially those implemented by for-profit international firms like Chemonics, is highly preferred. Knowledge and understanding of the Uganda National Bureau of Standards (UNBS) process is highly preferred.

The table below contains the list of services under RFQ, including for the JMS RF backbone and scanners/printers. Offerors are requested to provide quotations containing the information below on official letterhead or official quotation format. In the event this is not possible, offerors may complete this Section 3 and submit a signed/stamped version to Chemonics.
