1.	Section-3	What would you consider to be the Zambian equivalent of Unique Entity Identifier? Could it be related to Patents and Companies Registration Agency or Zambia Public Procurement Authority?  The Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) is a number issued by the US Federal Government to businesses or organizations working with/subcontracting for or doing business with the US Federal Government. The Zambian Government does not issue UEIs. A company can register for a UEI at SAM.gov  If you are not registered in SAM.gov, create a new registration by clicking on the "Get Started" link under the "Register Your Entity" heading in SAM.gov and follow the instructions.  Please provide the number if you have it. If you don't have one yet, we recommend you apply now as it will be requested at later stage of procurement, but this will not disqualify your response for this RFI.
2.	Section-3	If it applies to both, then Bidders may submit two identifier numbers? Companies can only submit one UEI number. Companies should submit any other relevant information to prove that they are fully registered in Zambia and can legally operate in Zambia.
3.	N/A	In which 6 provinces do you intend to carry out the program? The Mass campaign will be conducted in the 6 Presidents Malaria Initiative (PMI) focus Provinces namely: Eastern, Luapula, Muchinga, Northern, North-Western, and Western.
4.	N/A	When do you anticipate to start and end the program (period)?  The mass campaign is projected to start in August 2023 with a planned period of performance of 3 months. These dates are estimates and are subject to change depending on the arrival of bales in the country.
